JANUARY ACTIVITIES

Local Activities Overview:

In January 2021, Global Peace Mission has been handling several projects related to the well-being of the people in need. The monsoon season in the East Coast of Malaysia has led to major flood in that area. Several areas are affected including Pahang, Kelantan and Terengganu. Throughout January, GPM managed to provide support and aids to 4,700 beneficiaries who have been affected by the flood. Further details are provided below:

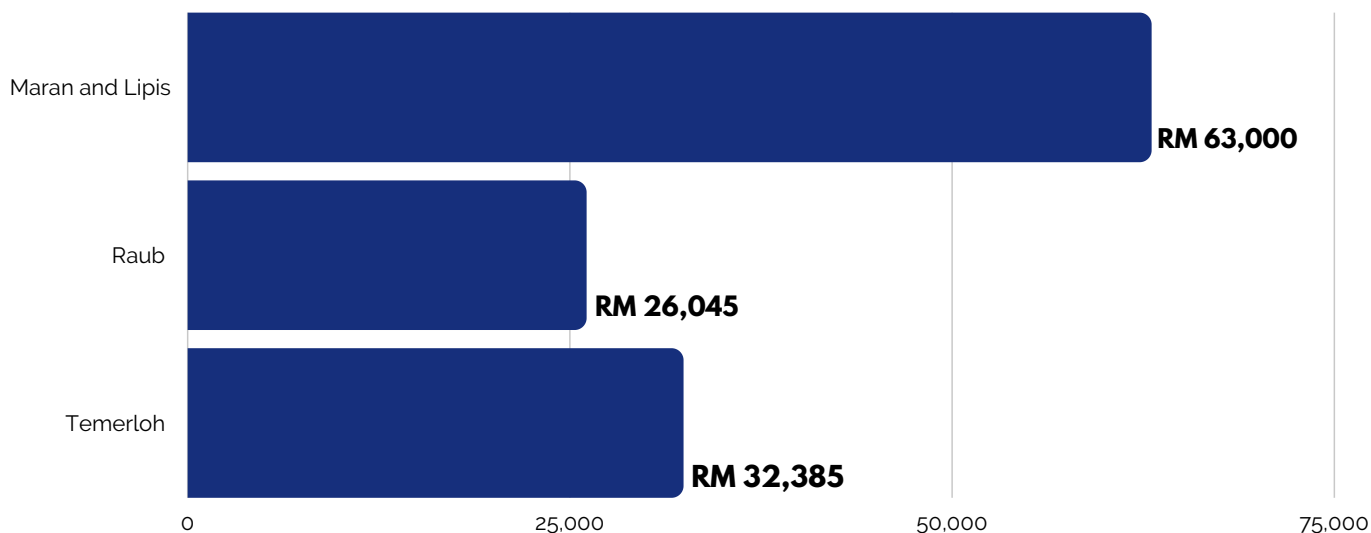
TOTAL NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES
