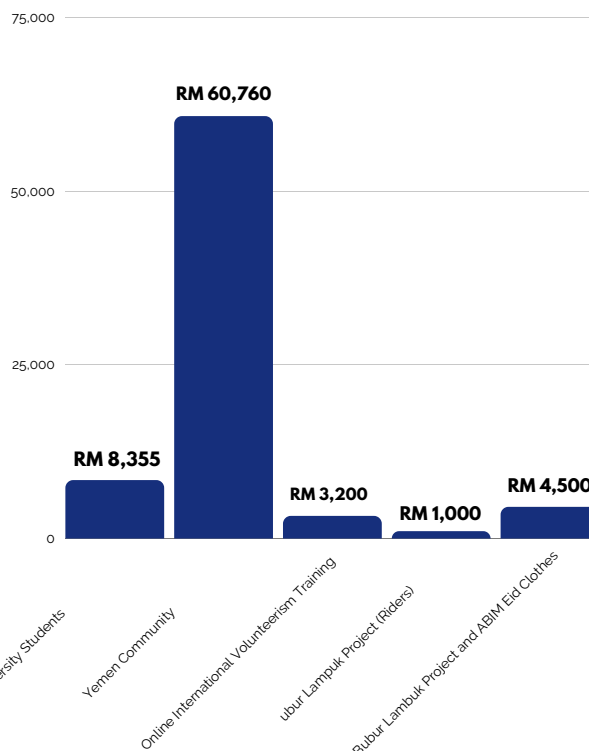
## TOTAL NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES
