When the government imposed the 'total lockdown', all economic and social sectors were not allowed to operate. Due to this issue, many people had lost their jobs and some can barely survive their days. In response, GPM launched AFTN: Lockdown 2.0, with an effort to supply foods and daily necessities to the people in need.


TOTAL NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES
