


EXECUTIVE SUMMARY





Name of project : Emergency Flood Relief Location : Kelantan, Terengganu and Johor Bahru Duration of project implementation : January 2023

Output

- Over 3,490 flood victims received asssistance and help around Kelantan, Terengganu and Johor Bahru.
- Cleaning work has been carried out in several houses in 6 villages in Kelantan and Terengganu.
- 8 temporary placement centre had received aid such as comforter, pillow, hygiene kit, cooking utensil, adult and kid dypers.

Description

- A tropical depression on December 2022 have led to major landfall in northeastern Malaysia and cause flood in few states through Peninsula Malaysia.
- This Emergency Flood Relief providing aids and support to the victims affected by the flood.
- Volunteers were deployed to assist the victims including in the distributions of food packs, blankets, clothes and hygiene equipment.
- This programme alocated **RM 25,050.68** for emergency flood relief in Peninsula Malaysia.







Name of project : Winter Aid for The Needy Location : Yemen & Afghanistan Duration of implementation project : January 2023

Output

- Over 100 orphans at Yemen had received blankets for winter .
- Around 60 families and and Internal Displace Person (IDP) had received food pack assistant in Afghanistan .

Description

- Winter Aid for The Needy (WAFTN) is an annual program of Global Peace Mission (GPM) Malaysia that focuses in providing people with food pack, winter clothing kits including sweater, winter hats, gloves & socks, blankets & fuels.
- This program is specifically carried out during the winter seasons in order to help them to get through the winter season especially for helping the underprivileged people during the winter .
- This programme alocated **RM 43,742.11** for WAFTN in Yemen and Afghanistan.


Name of project : Earthquake Emergency Relief Location : Turkiye and Syria Duration of implementation project : Mac 2023

Output

- Over 10,307 earthquake victims received hot meals , food pack , Ready to Eat (RTE) food, Iftar and sahur meals, hygiene kits, baby milk and diapers.
- 34 sandwich panel houses was been built.


Description

- The 7.8 and 7.5 magnitude earthquakes brought widespread devastation to both Turkey and Syria, with the total numbers of lives lost, injuries and destroyed buildings continuing to rise a month after the quakes.
- The death toll from earthquakes in Turkey and Syria has surpassed 50,000 people—including 45,968 confirmed deaths in Turkey and 7,259 in Syria.
- Global Peace Mission (GPM) teams was among the first Non Government Organization that arrive in Türkiye and Syria to provide physical and emotional assistance to the victims together with sending the needs and goods that was needed by the earthquake victims.
- GPM also are providing group activities for and consultations to vulnerable women, girls and children currently living in temporary shelters and camps.
- Services include running awareness-raising sessions, providing safe spaces where children can express their fears and emotions, and distributing games and toys for children. The teams had reached more than 1000 women, girls and children.
- This emergency appeal allocated **RM 1,303,514.36 millions** for this earthquake emergency relief.














Name of project : GPM Malaysia donate Air Filter Mask to Civil Defence Authority Location : Turkiye and Syria Duration of implementation project : Mac 2023

Output

• 50 air filter mask was given to the civil defence authority for the usage during emergency especially duriang war.

Description

- As the attack was launched during the day, Gaza's civil defense contacted GPM to get supplies of air filters as their supply was insufficient.
- Therefore, GPM has helped by supplying as many as 50 air filters for the use of face masks for them.
- The air filter is used to protect personnel from air pollution and poisonous gases when an attack occurs.


OUR WORK : INTERNATIONAL AIR FILTER MASK TO CIVIL DEFENCE AUTHORITY



Description

Description

GPM Malaysia team together with the Malaysia for Syria (MFS) team, and the *Prihatin* Turkiye - Syria NGO Coalition have jointly helped in managing the relief goods that have been donated by Malaysians where the goods will be brought to Syria for the affected earthquake victims. The sorting, packaging, and labeling of goods has been done at SMART Headquarters, Pulau Meranti, Puchong. These donated items will be sent to the RMAF Airbase, Subang for delivery to Syria via Turkish Airlines.



Name of activities : My Multifaith Fundraising for Turkiye and Syria Lunching Ceremony Location : Kuala Lumpur Date : 20 February 2023

Description

GPM Malaysia together with 37 local organizations joined forces to launch a special fund to collect funds to help Turkey & Syria due to the 7.8 Ritcher scale earthquake that hit the two countries last February 6. The earthquake claimed more than 40,000 lives and damaged thousands of buildings and homes. Now is the phase to rebuild Türkiye & Syria but in the winter now, it is quite difficult for the. The 37 participating organizations consist of various religious organizations & non-governmental organizations (NGOs) who work together using their respective spheres of influence to raise funds & deliver humanitarian aid to disaster victims in Türkiye & Syria.

GPM Malaysia in collaboration with Mega Clinic Dr. Suffian and Youth Empowerment Support held a program to distribute school supplies and health checks to 100 Somali refugee children. In addition to school children, health checks for their parents are also carried out. By helping in terms of health and education, we hope that these Somali refugees can focus on improving their quality of life and then fight to free their country from the ongoing conflict there.
