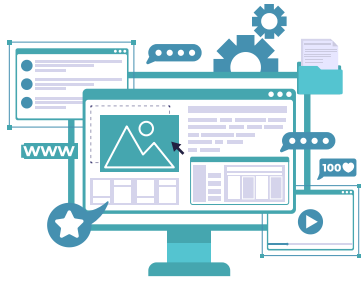


EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

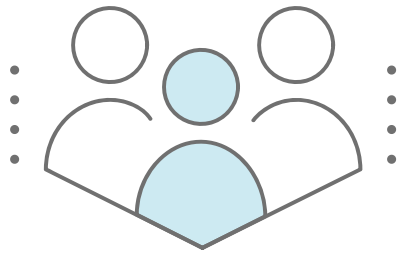

- This programme allocated **RM 199,904.00** for IFTN programme in Malaysia for 2023 .



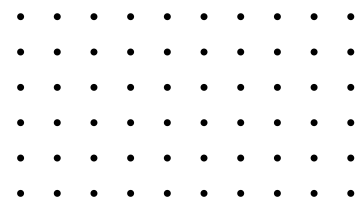

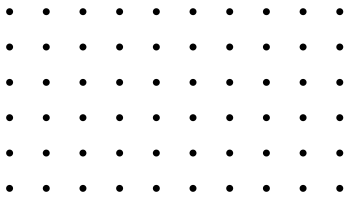

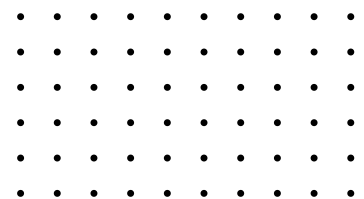

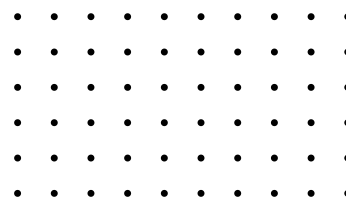

Location : Maluku, Indonesia

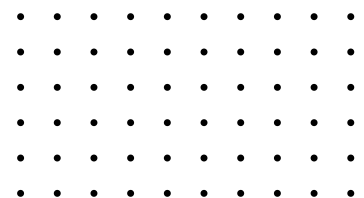
Duration of implementation project : 26 Mei 2023 – 1 Jun 2023

Output

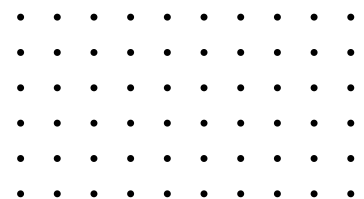
- The construction of this school will benefit 300 families around the area.
- Currently, a total of 49 students and 14 teachers are in the school that had being built.

Description

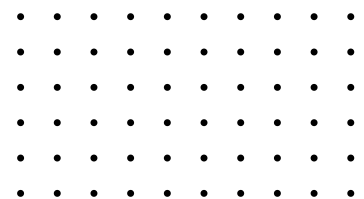
- The school that had been built by GPM Malaysia in collaboration with GFI and ALASKA was to prepare for a proper educational facilities for the local community.
- Before the existing of school, students was boarded at small community hall around the village as a place to study.
- Most of the families here are new Muslim members or just converted their religion to Islam. They still requires continuous religious education apart from academic education.
- So far only 2 classes have been completed. The next plan is to build additional 1 classroom, teacher's room and also library.
- This school is to Provide a complete educational infrastructure in Kanafa Hamlet Area
- It was also to Eradicate the problem of illiteracy among the population
- Upgrading community life through Education.
- This project allocated **RM 25,000.00** for MTS Amwar School Construction at Maluku, Indonesia.
