




EXECUTIVE SUMMARY



Name of activities: Submission of a memorandum of oppression against the Palestinian people at the Embassy of the United States

Location: Embassy of the United States

Date: 3 July 2023

Description

This memorandum was submitted by the Secretary General of the Malaysia Islamic Youth Movement (ABIM), Mohammad Fazril bin Mohd Saleh accompanied by the Deputy President of ABIM, Khairul Anuar Ismail and the Chief Executive Officer of GPM Malaysia himself, Ahmad Fahmi Samsudin.

On July 3, 2023 (Monday), according to Palestine Ministry of Health, Israel launched its largest military operation in Jenin, Palestine. Due to that, it killed at least 12 Palestinians and injured more than 100 others. Reportedly, Palestinian residents there were also arrested and driven from their own homes.

This memorandum urges the United States (US) Embassy to urge international responsibilities that protect the right to freedom and prevent oppression and cruelty against the Palestinian people that had been done by Israel.





Name of activities: Submission of a memorandum of oppression

against the Uyghur ethnic group at the Chinese Embassy

Location: Embassy of China

Date: 5 July 2023

Description

On 5 July, 2023 marks the 14th anniversary of the Urumqi Massacre / genocide against the Uyghur Muslim ethnic group that took place in the capital of East Turkistan (Xinjiang).

This black event is one of a series of atrocities, persecution, cruelty and inhumane actions that carried out by the Chinese government against the Uyghur people over the past few decades.

In conjunction with this event, a memorandum was handed over at the Chinese embassy led by the Secretary General of the Malaysia Islamic Youth Movement (ABIM), Mohammad Fazril bin Mohd Saleh, accompanied by the Deputy President of ABIM, Khairul Anuar Ismail and the Chief Executive Officer of GPM Malaysia himself, Ahmad Fahmi Samsudin.

This memorandum urges the Chinese government to respect, protect the right to religious freedom and provide equal protection to the Uyghur ethnic group who are facing oppression and brutality in the Xinjiang region.
