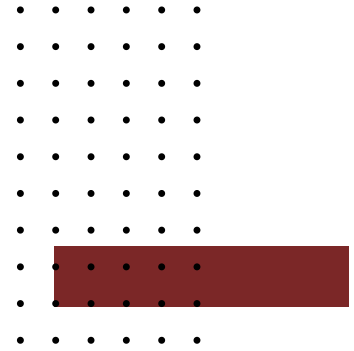

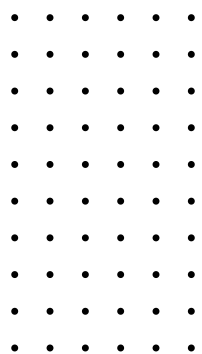

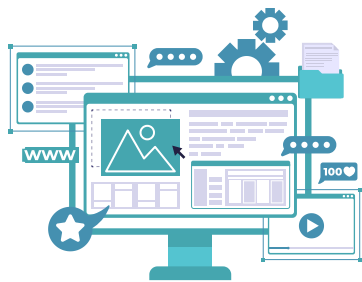


EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

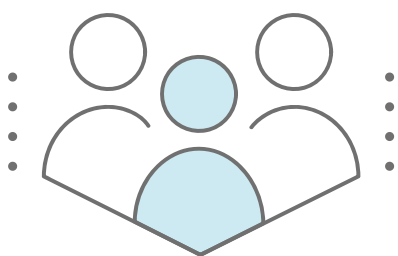

Name of project :Flood Aid Relief

Location : Kelantan

Duration of project implementation : 29 December 2023

Output

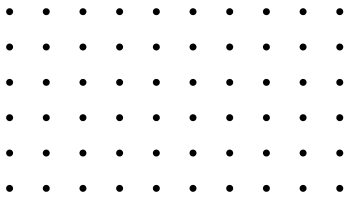
- 300 families received flood assistance by GPM Malaysia such as ready to eat (RTE) food, dypers and blankets.

Description

- This mission include some forms of aid include dry food and maize rice, washing lamps, daughters and baby milk.
- Assistance is provided in Bandar Rantau Panjang, Kg Gual Bunut and Gual Periok areas. .
- This flood relief project allocated **RM 18,000.00** for the mission.

Name of project : Telaga Al Mukhlis

Location: Nigeria

Duration of project implementation : September & November 2023

Output

- 13 water wells had been built for the communities.
- These water wells can be used for about 13 thousands people around the area.

Description

- Previously GPM Malaysia have completed the construction of 30 Al Mukhlis wells in Nigeria.
- The donation collected for Al Mukhlis Well will help the Muslim minority in Nigeria who are in need of clean water supply.
- This project allocated **RM 26,000.00** for this water well project from September to December 2023.

Name of project : Masjid Ahmad Ammar

Location : Nigeria

Duration of implementation project : November 2023 - ongoing

Output

- This project still in progress and still needed 2 millions to complete the whole construction of the mosque.

Description

- There are 6,000 Muslim communities living in Ayegun, Nigeria, but there is still no mosque built that allows them to worship in congregation prayer comfortably.
- GPM Malaysia in progress to build a Mosque in Ayegun, Nigeria as a result of all your waqf funds to make it easier for the Muslim community there to worship.

Output

- Approximately 40 participants took part in the Soft Skills workshop, led by an experienced facilitator.
- The workshop garnered complete focus regarding its explanations, hands-on exercises, and theoretical insights.

Description

- This vocational project at Al Anbar, Iraq focus on vocational training for people who doesn't has job. The training that they provide are soft skills training , food and confectionary productions workshop, hairdressing and beauty therapy workshop, cctv cameras and security system workshop and solar power system workshop.
- This project allocated around **RM 111,078.28** for the vocational training.

Output

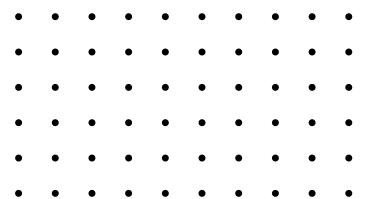
- The school rehabilitation project can benefit more than 1000 students and 250 families.

Name of activities : Basic Emergency Bug Out (BOB) for Flood Victims sponsored by Zurich Malaysia.

Location : Bangi Lama Village , Selangor

Date : 12 December 2024

Description

- Global Peace Mission (GPM) Malaysia together with Zurich Malaysia have handed over 100 flood preparation kit bags to those affected by the floods in Bangi Lama.
- Bangi Lama, Selangor, is one of the areas affected by the repeated flooding phenomenon.
- Since 2022, the place has been flooded almost 15 times. It was reported that many houses and roads were damaged due to the flash floods that occurred.
- The aid bag provided contains: first aid kit, medicines (panadol, cough medicine), emergency blanket, 3 in whistle, power bank, mineral water & energy bar, aquatabs, solar hand crack flashlight.
- **RM200,000** thousand allocated for this flood Basic Emergency Bug Out (BOB).

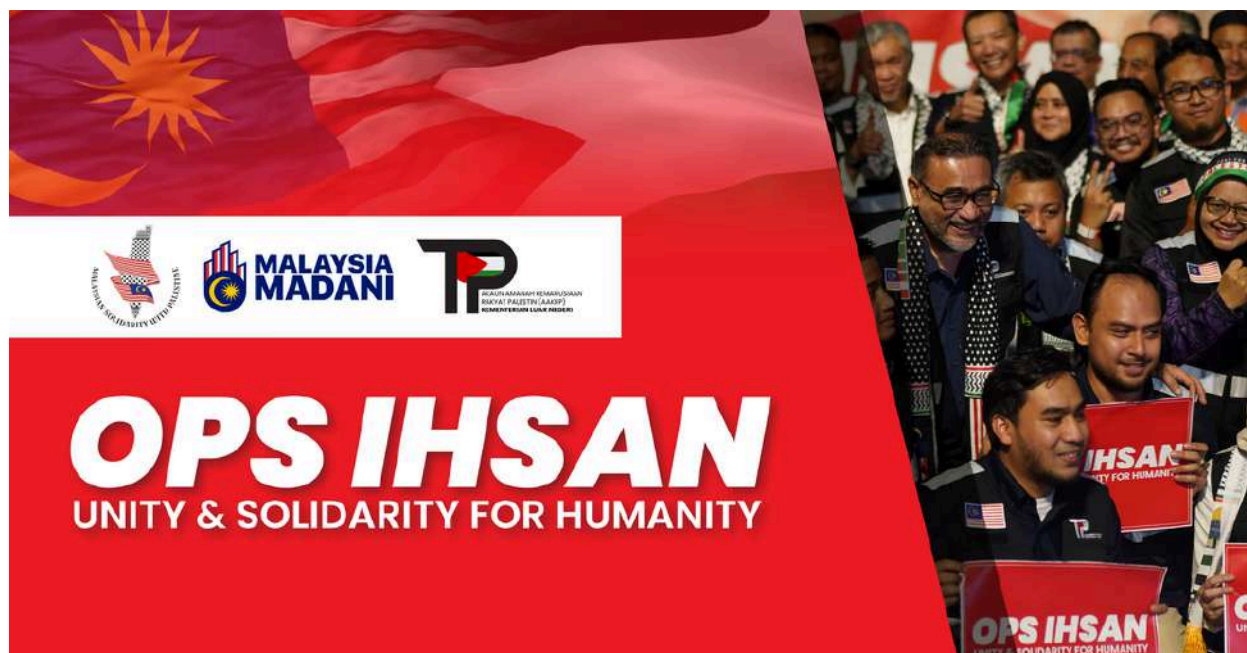
Name of activities : *Ops Ihsan*

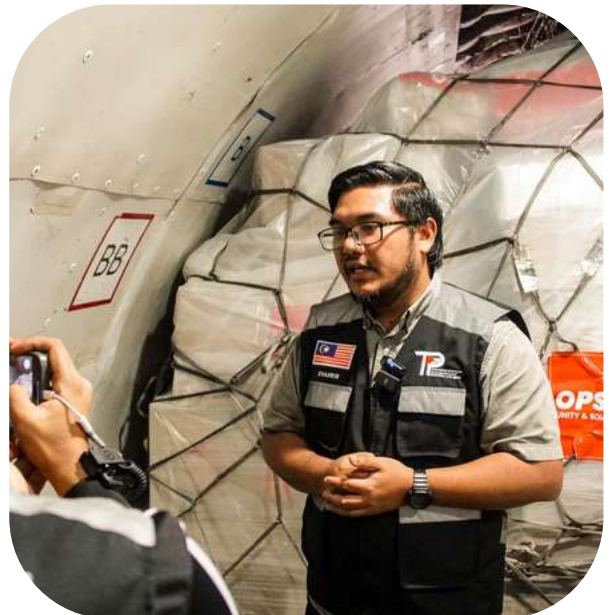
Location : Kuala Lumpur

Description

- Inspired by Dato' Seri Diraja Dr. Zambry Abdul Kadir as a collaborative effort between the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and several non-governmental organizations (NGOs), stands as evidence of the rapid and efficient mobilization of humanitarian aid in response to urgent needs.
- In a remarkable achievement, the NGO coordinated the collection of essential humanitarian aid items in less than 48 hours, specifically on 21 and 22 October. GPM Malaysia is one of the main organizer for Ops Ihsan.
- Three different kargo flight at three different day brought about in total 96 tons of food packs and babies necessities, medical aids, women necessities and winter aids that cost RM 13 millions.
