ABOUT US

Global Peace Mission (GPM) Malaysia is a Trust Foundation which is incorporated under the Trustee Act (Incorporation) 1952, Legal Affairs Division (BHEUU), Prime Minister Office (PMO) of Malaysia. It was established on 26th September 2001 as a response to the emergency needs for Afghanistan conflict. When Afghanistan was in dire needs of support in early October of the same year, GPM had mobilized a humanitarian and medical aid mission to help the victims of war.

Since then, aside from actively providing emergency assistance, GPM has been providing other humanitarian aid not only to Afghanistan but to nearly 30 countries in need worldwide. GPM has been actively involved in promoting the importance of fostering and maintaining universal peace through awareness programs and information for the community as well as raising funds to assist victims of war and natural disasters such as floods, earthquakes, famine, and tsunami.






Name of activities : Iftar for the Needy (IFTN) Location : Kuala Lumpur, Kelantan dan Selangor Date : March 2024



Output

• Over 30,001 individuals received food pack and iftar assistance during the month of Ramadhan.

Description

Name of activities : Egypt Humanitarian Mission Location : Palestine/Gaza, Attar camp, Rafah camp, Shakoush camp Date : February 2024

Description

The project aimed to improve the food security of the most vulnerable Internal Displace Person (IDP) families in Gaza that affected by the current war including widows/widowers, female-headed households, single male headed households, people living with disabilities, the elderly, and especially those living inside camps, by ensuring immediate direct access to food and enhancing resilience. This project targeted 2,400 families by providing each family food pack assistance that contains the basic food need of the family. This project allocated **RM 416, 970. 19** for this project.





Name of activities : Cheque Giving Ceremony from Ministry of Education. Location : Ministry of Education Date : 1 March 2024

Description

GPM received donation for Gaza personally handed by YB Fadhlina Sidek, Malaysian Minister of Education. The donation will be channeled to people in need in Gaza.



Name of activities : Pre Departure Training Location : Gpm Hq Date : 16 January 2024

Description

GPM organized Pre-Departure Training for all staff guided by Datin Azura CEO Red A Humanitarian Development Global. The goal of predeparture training is to equip all staff with the knowledge, skills, and information they need to successfully adapt to the new environment and handle potential challenges in the foreign country. Pre-departure training typically includes cultural awareness, logistical preparation, health safety, work or study specific guidance and coping with culture shock. Pre-departure training helps ensure smoother transitions and reduces the risk of potential difficulties upon arrival in the destination country. It is often organized by employers, educational institutions, volunteer organizations, or travel agencies.

Description

GPM meet with United Sabah Islamic Association (USIA) in order to discuss more about the distribution of donation for Palestinian people in Gaza that handled by GPM. USIA Sabah donate **RM 200,000.00** for Gaza. During this critical phase in Gaza, GPM will channel the donation to the main factor that need more attention which are:

- Humanitarian Aid: Allocate funds for immediate needs such as food, clean water, hygiene kits, and shelter.
- Medical Support: Direct funds to hospitals and clinics in Gaza for medical supplies urgent care services.

Description

Since the first day of the war, the Gaza GPM team managed by Dr. Tareq AlTalmas has helped provide non-stop humanitarian contributions to the Palestinian people in Gaza.

Despite facing various risks, they continue to commit channeling the contributions given by Malaysians.





Name of activities: GPM Gaza distributed dypers, baby milk and blankets to war victims in Gaza.
Location: Gaza, Palestine.

Description

Since the first day of the war, GPM Gaza team managed by Dr Tareq AlTalmas has not stopped providing aid to the Palestinian people in Gaza despite facing various risks when channeling the donations given by Malaysians.

The distribution of aid this time also got the cooperation of Golden Future Indonesia (a non-governmental organization from Indonesia that is also active in providing humanitarian aid. Manage the needs of the people of Gaza who are in the hospital.





Name of activities :GPM Gaza distributed medical aids to war victims in Gaza.
Location : Gaza, Palestine.

Description

This time, the Gaza GPM team distributed aid to injured victims in a hospital.

A number of funds have also been given to the Al Salama Organization to help the team manage the needs of the people of Gaza who are in the hospital.

Name of activities :GPM Gaza distributed 200,000 thousand liters clean water to war victims in Gaza. Location : Gaza, Palestine. Date : January 2024

Description

The suffering of the Palestinian Muslims in Gaza is doubled, they do not have an adequate supply of clean water. Because of that, they had to drink unclean water and caused them to suffer from various diseases.

Therefore, the Gaza GPM team decided to find a water supply and distribute the clean drinking water supply. More than 100 liters of clean drinking water have been distributed to war victims who are sheltering in shelters around the Al Nusairat area.

So far, the amount of clean drinking water that has been distributed has already reached 200,000 liters (30 liters/day).

Description

GPM Gaza has delivered food baskets to war victims who have lost their homes. Most of them live in the gaps of houses that have suffered severe damage, some also live in tents built from discarded items.

The aid is in the form of their daily food needs. At this time the situation is very acute, the supply of food is difficult to find in the market. GPM Gaza strives to get food supplies everywhere to donate to those in need.

GPM together with other NGO's in Malaysia held a demonstration as our support to people in Gaza. The demonstration start from Tabung Haji Tower to Padang Merbok by Raising Palestine Flags. The demonstration can help to inform people who may not be fully aware of the issues surrounding Palestine. This can lead more individuals educating themselves, engaging in discussions, and advocating for change.





Name of activities: Donation of Hospital Bed, Wheelchair & Medical Toilet for Uncle Jamaludin. Location : Sg Rambai, Malacca Date : 15 February 2024

Description

GPM's Hq Team in collaboration with the GPM Melaka branch team went to Sg Rambai Melaka to deliver a donation of medical equipment for Uncle Jamaludin who was diagnosed with chronic diabetes. Uncle Jamaludin's condition is very unfavorable considering that his left leg was amputated two months ago while his right leg was amputated a few years ago. Now, he is looked after by his son (Iskandar) who had to quit his job to look after Pakcik Jamaludin full time. Therefore, they are completely dependent on the help provided. Through the survey, Uncle Jamaludin's house is also in an imperfect state. The roof of his house has been leaking for the past 10 years and has not been repaired.





Name of activities: Clean Air Pump Operation Assistance. Location: Gaza Date: February 2024

Description

In order to ensure that mosques in Gaza get a supply of clean water, GPM Gaza led by Dr Tareq Al Talmas has taken the initiative to supply diesel oil for generator use there. The generator works to turn on the pump and filter the clean water supply used by Palestinians to perform ablution.

In addition to providing clean water for ablution, the mosque also opens up opportunities for Palestinians to take clean water supplies for daily use and drinking.





Name of activities : Distribution of 72 baskets of vegetables. Location : Gaza Date : February 2024

Description

GPM Gaza has delivered food aid in the form of vegetables to war victims who lost their homes around Rafah. This vegetable basket is able to provide food to approximately 700 beneficiaries.

Even though Rafah is currently under attack, the Gaza GPM team does not consider the risk as an obstacle to continue the aid distribution process there.

Aid from Malaysians through the Global Peace Mission (GPM) Malaysia continues to be channeled despite facing various constraints and challenges.





Name of activities: Frozen Chicken Distribution. Location: Gaza Date: February 2024

Description

GPM Gaza team managed to distribute frozen chicken to 240 families (1 chicken/1 family). This aid is distributed to war victims who have lost their homes around Rafah and Khan Younis.





Name of activities: Distribution of 100 baskets of vegetables. Location: Gaza Date: Februari 2024

Description

Alhamdulillah, aid for Palestine managed by the Gaza GPM team was successfully distributed around Rafah. A total of 100 vegetable baskets were distributed to 100 families who lost their homes due to the war.
